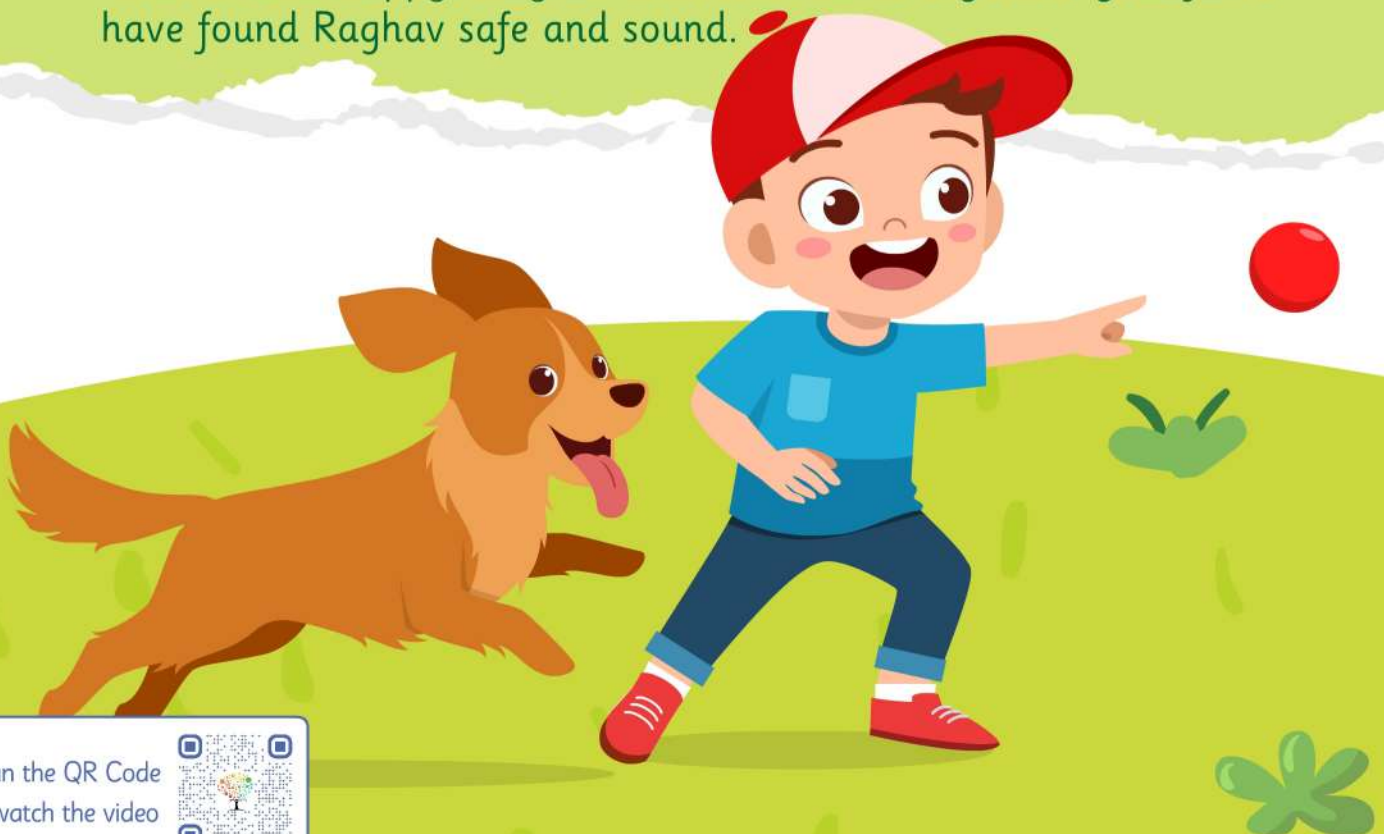
Raghav's adventure
