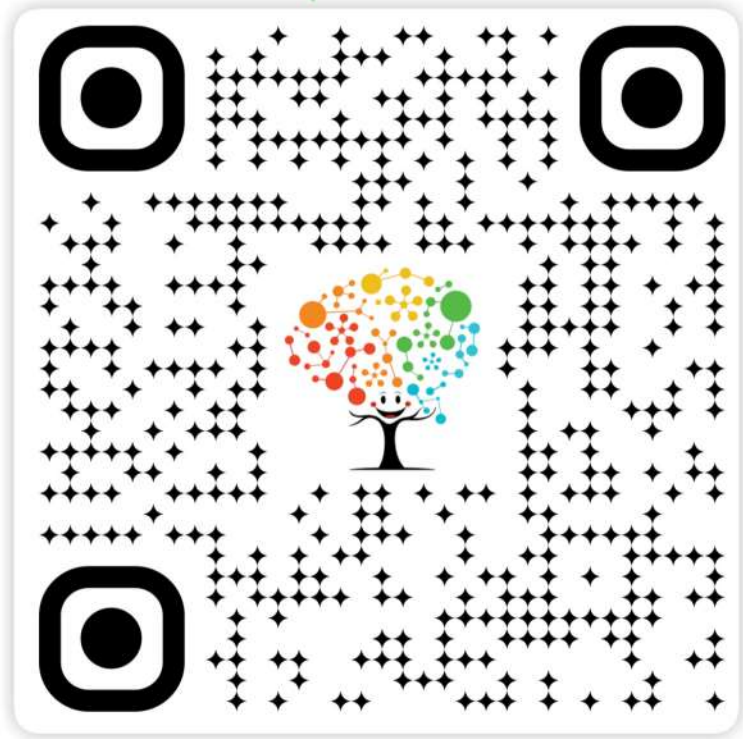

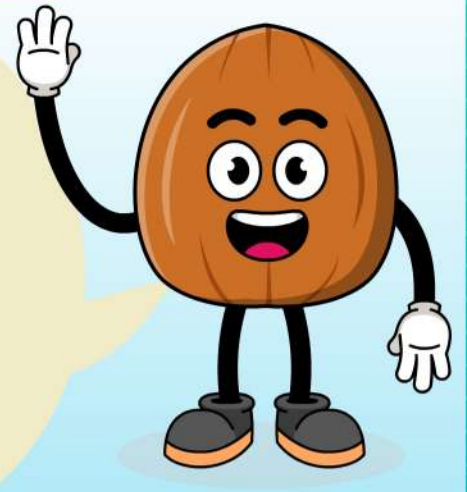

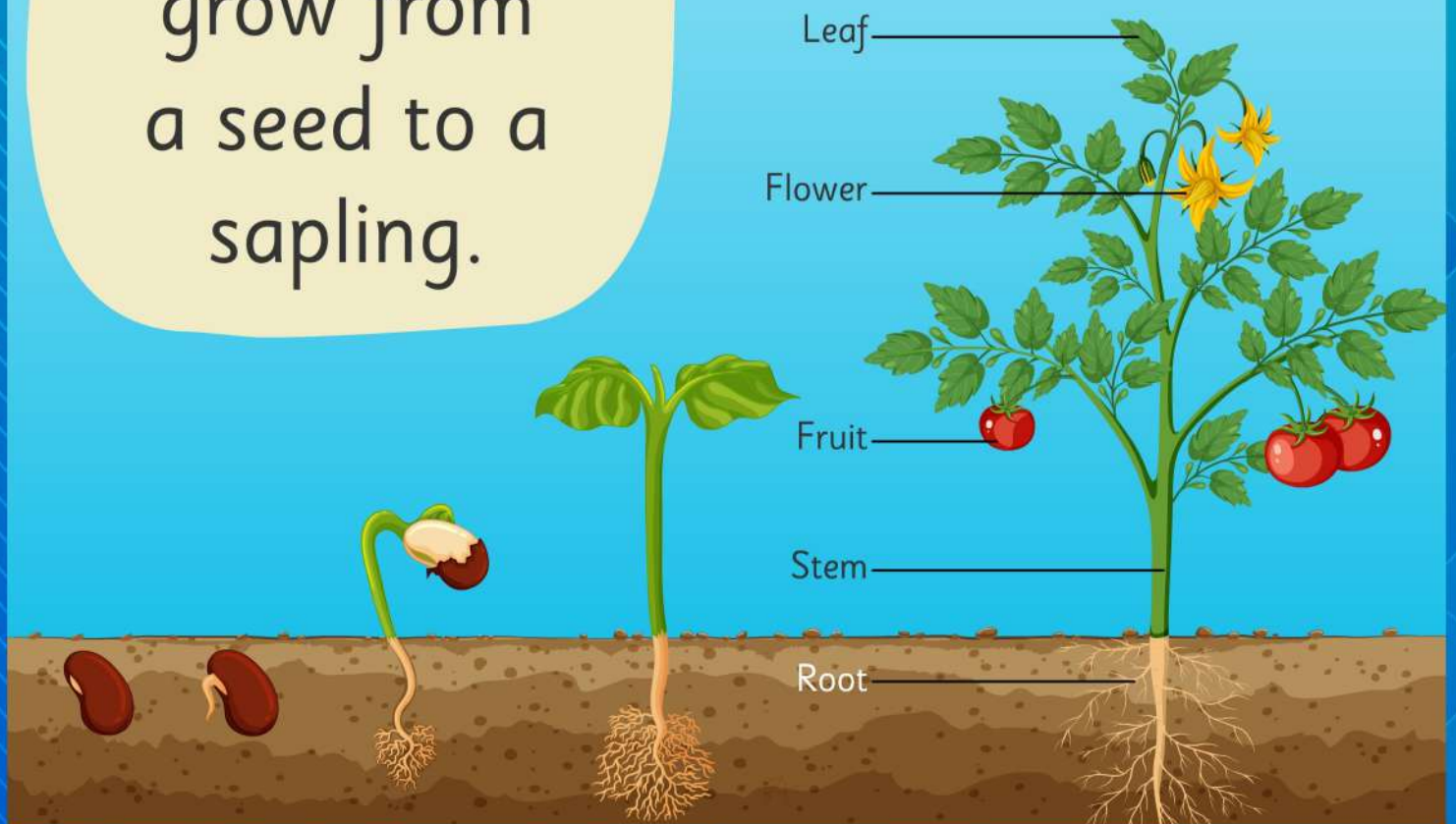
(Parts of a plant)

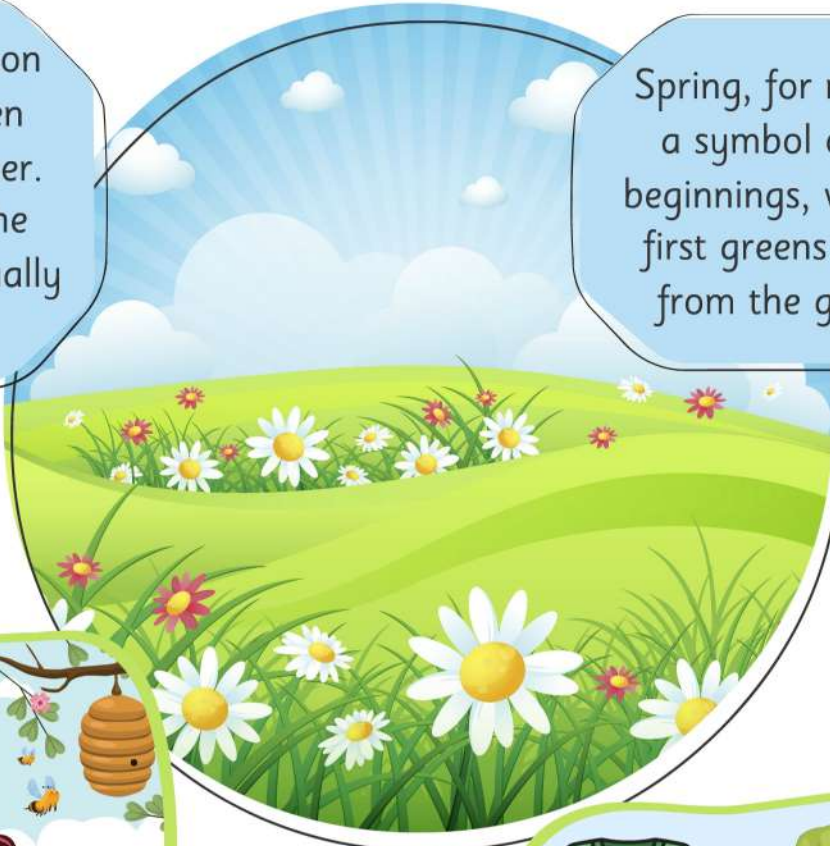
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Spring Season

Spring is the season that falls between winter and summer. During spring, the temperature gradually rises.

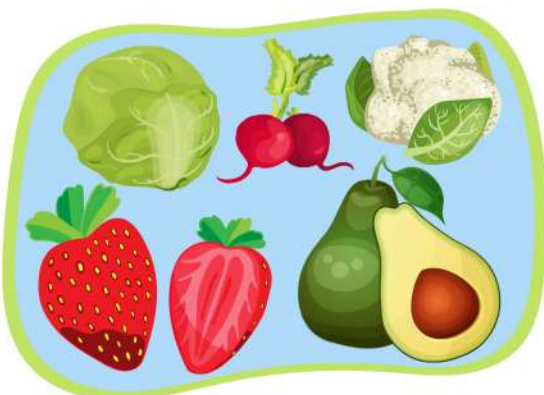
Spring, for many, is a symbol of new beginnings, when the first greens emerge from the ground.

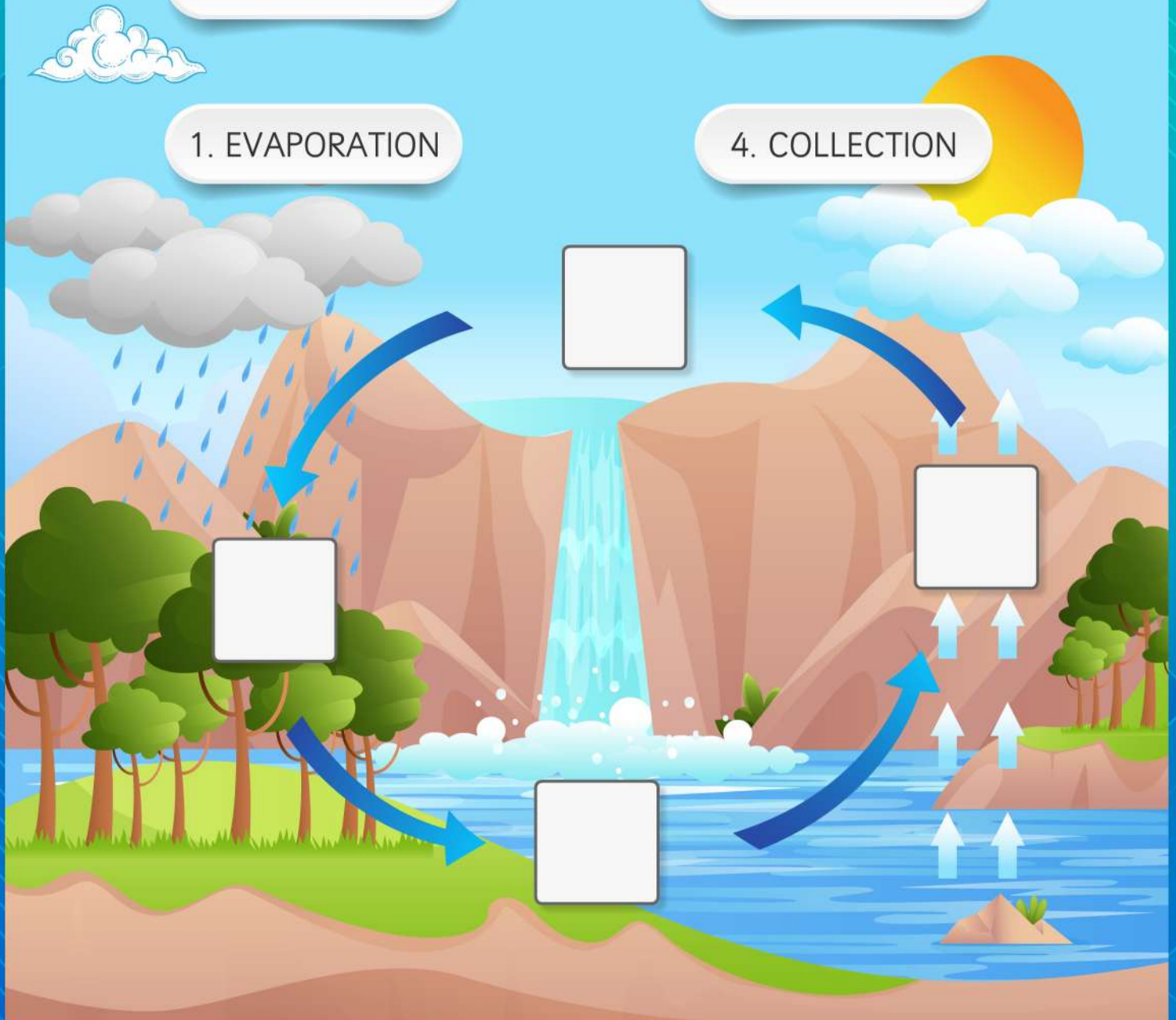

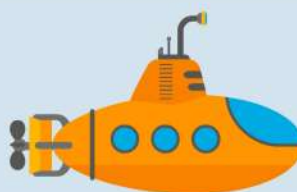

Apartment- An apartment is a residential unit that is part of one (or several) residential buildings.



Bungalow - A bungalow is a style of house or cottage that is typically either a single story or has a second, half, or partial story, that is built into a sloped roof.



Office- A room, set of rooms, or building used as a place for commercial, professional work.



Factory- A building or group of buildings where goods are manufactured or assembled mainly by machine. "A textile factory".



School - A school is a building designed to provide learning spaces and learning environments for students.



Villa- A villa style house is traditionally a more secluded house, often single-level, designed to be a home for a single family, usually on spacious property
